Congratulations to all our senior students on their NCEA results for 2025. We are incredibly proud of how well our students have achieved and excited to share that 5 of our Year 13s have been awarded Scholarships:

- **Amber Cayley** (History and Biology)
- **Sasha Maclean** (History)
- **Sienna Asi** (Religious Studies)
- **Molly Sergent-Shadbolt** (Religious Studies)
- **Ellie Klampfer-Edgcombe** (Chemistry)

We continue to record superb NCEA Literacy and Numeracy results. Our success rates are as follows:

- SHGC Year 11: 97.1% of students (national average 73.4%),
- SHGC Year 12: 98.2% (national average 84.5%)
- SHGC Year 13: 100% (national average 90.6%)

Our proportions achieving NCEA at each year level are well above national averages:

- 93.0% of Year 11 students achieved NCEA Level 1 (national average 72.1%)
- 90.4% of Year 12 students achieved NCEA Level 2 (national average 72.7%)
- 84.0% of Year 13 students achieved NCEA Level 3 (national average 70.4%)

Please note our Excellence assembly to recognise student success will be held on Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> March at 10.15am in the Events Centre. Parents and whānau are welcome to attend.

Our school values of Ako, Manaakitanga and Wāhine Toa help us focus on how we will make the most of our time at school. Let's remember: **Ako** – we take every opportunity to learn 'Whatever you do work at it with all your heart' (Colossians 3: 23), **Manaakitanga** – we love and respect one another 'As I have loved you, so you must love one another' (John 13:34) and **Wāhine Toa** – we love and respect ourselves 'Every person is made in the image of God' (Genesis 1:27).

In addition to our Special Character focus on our charism, our new strategic plan has a focus on improving engagement and resilience in our learners and growing respect and understanding of Te Reo Māori me ōna tikanga. We continue to focus on improving attendance as we have already communicated with you. You can find our Attendance Management Plan on our website. Please be in contact with the Manaaki teacher or Dean about attendance.

The start of this year has seen the completion of our new Food Technology and Textiles Technology learning spaces and the DVC rooms will be completed soon. We thank the Mission College New Plymouth Trust Board for providing us with such magnificent, future focused spaces (see page 11).

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**Beginning of and end of school day** – please do not drop off or pick up your daughter inside the school grounds at the start of the day, or when collecting at the end of the day. We do not have adequate parking nor room to easily turn around. Ask her to walk across the road at the crossing on Paynters Avenue where it is much safer to park. Vehicles turning around on Pukaka St are a health and safety hazard to students and our staff. Please note there is no stopping or parking in Pukaka St during school days under NPDC parking rules.



**Medication** – we do not hand out panadol (or any other medication) at school, unless we have permission noted on our system from a parent/caregiver. If your daughter is unwell, our policy is to contact you to pick her up as soon as possible.

**Student appointments/illness – Admin office first contact** – We are finding that some students are not following correct procedure for sickness/appointments. If a student is unwell or they wish to leave school due to an appointment, please tell them to come to the front office so staff can make contact with parents/caregivers if necessary. If the office staff are not made aware of these situations it becomes difficult to locate the student or more importantly assist the student if they are unwell.

**Leaving school grounds** – if your daughter needs to leave the school grounds she will need a signed note from home. If she does not bring one, we will contact you before giving permission.

### *Expectations of students*

At Manawa Tapu we take great pride in our students and have high expectations of them. As Wāhine Toa, we expect students to wear their uniform correctly, be in class on time and be engaged in their learning. As the lead pastoral carer, the Manaaki teacher will support our students in meeting these expectations. This is the pastoral process our Manaaki teachers use if there is an attendance or uniform issue:

Student is not meeting expectations	Low level restorative chat. The student is reminded of the expectations.
Not resolved	Expectations are revisited – The teachers makes a note in the student management system.
Not resolved	Teacher <b>contacts home</b> and makes a note in the student management system.
Not resolved	The teacher refers the issue to the Year Level Dean.

We really appreciate the role caregivers have and the support they provide in helping our students meet Manawa Tapu's behavioural expectations. If you would like to discuss uniform or attendance, please contact your daughter's Manaaki Teacher in the first instance. ### *Attendance Goals*

Regular attendance at school is a key factor in a successful education and positive outcomes later in life. Ideally, students should only be absent for justified reasons. Examples of a justified absence:



- Unplanned absence such as a vehicle break down, accident, road closure
- Planned non-attendance such as local/national representation in a sporting or cultural event
- Attendance at a funeral or tangihanga
- Illness or medical reasons

We will be asking for evidence from a medical professional to support any medical absence longer than three consecutive school days and any student who has had more than three days unjustified absence will be referred to the Central New Plymouth Attendance Service. Participation in extra and co-curricular activities will be contingent upon a student keeping their unjustified attendance rate below 15%.

If a student is absent during term time for a family trip for example, this is an unjustified absence. An email to the Manaaki Teacher and Dean should be sent prior to taking the trip.

### *Cell Phones*

A reminder of our cellphone expectations: All Students – cellphones are not to be used or seen during school hours (8.40am – 3.10pm). Cellphones can be turned off and left in the students' bag or left at home. Students are not to carry them on their person during the school day.



If you need to contact your young person during the school day you can either email them or ring the school office and a message will be passed on.

We really appreciate the role caregivers have and the support they provide in helping our students meet Manawa Tapu's behavioural expectations. If you would like to discuss any pastoral issues, please contact your daughter's Manaaki Teacher in the first instance.

### *Art Competition—Toyota Dream Car Contest*

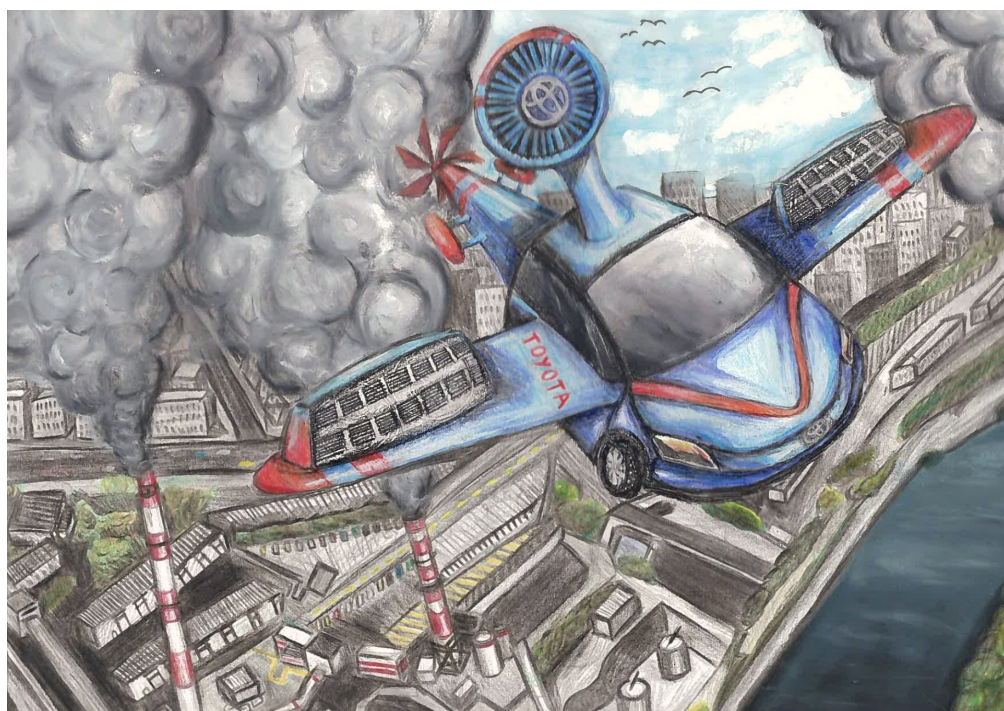
Over the holidays I entered the Toyota Dream Car Contest. It is a contest from ages 4 to 15 that has been created to inspire children to imagine the future of mobility.

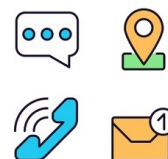

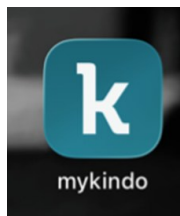
*Lunchonline has changed to mykindo Ezlunch*

Ezlunch acquired Lunchonline, and all services were moved onto the MyKindo/Ezlunch platform.

Our school's menus, suppliers and lunch days stay the same. Your balance is transferred automatically, if you had money in your lunchonline account.

Here are steps to set up the myKindo App on your phone:

1. Download the myKindo App



2. Enter your email from lunchonline account.

3. Click Forgot password – a link will arrive in your email inbox (it can take a little while). If it says no family with that account, then you used a different email for your lunchonline.

4. Change password through link.

5. Go back to myKindo and login using new password.

6. There are two buttons at the bottom, Home and Account.

7. Your balance from lunchonline can be seen in Account, myKindo Wallet.

8. Click on Account, My Details and scroll down to add a member (who the lunch is for), add our school. Save.

9. Now 3 buttons should show at the bottom – the third one is ezlunch. You can order from there or from the Home page.
